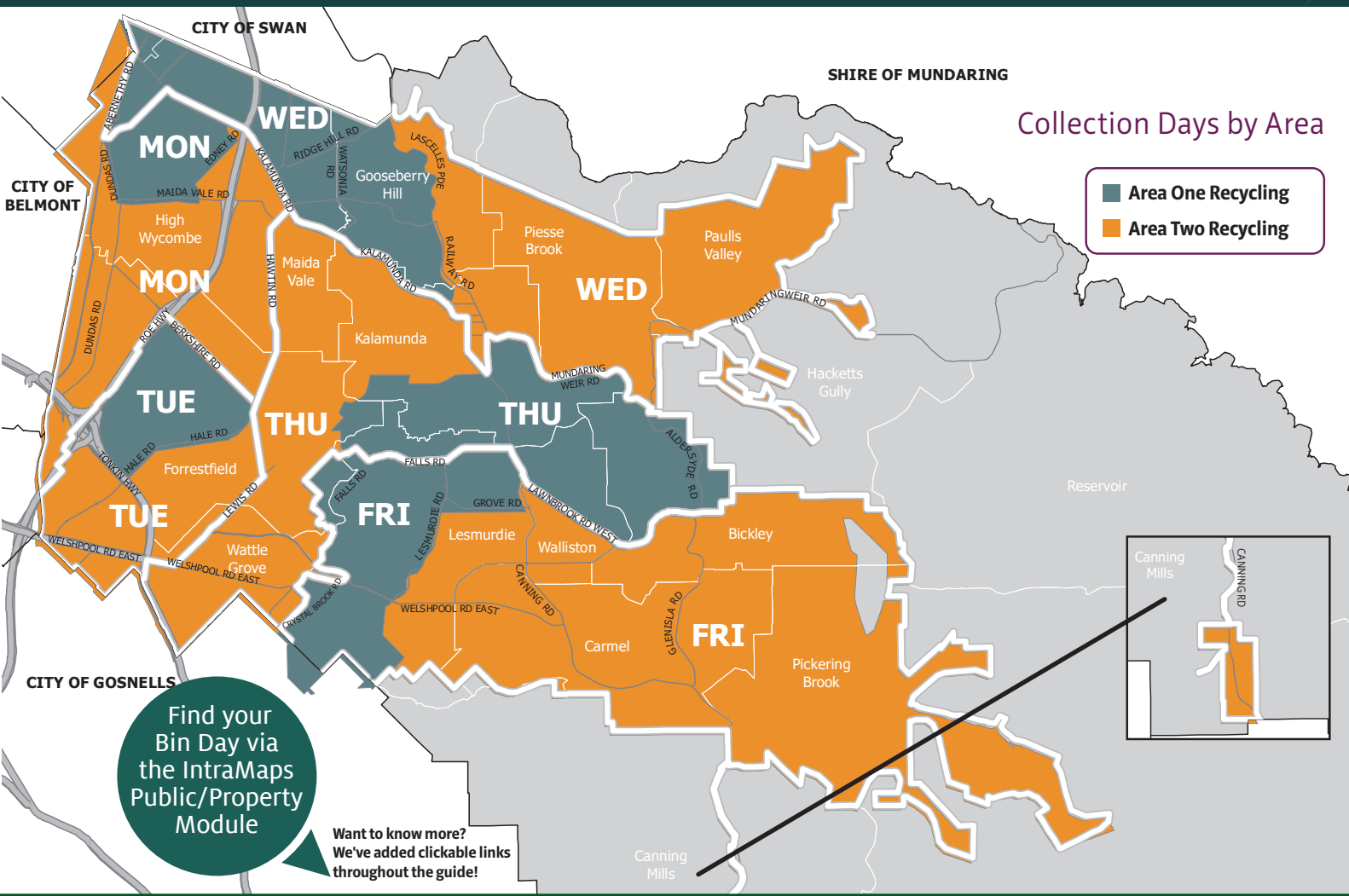

3 Mattress and Whitegoods Collection Service

The City of Kalamunda offers a mattress and whitegoods collection service for a fee. For more information or to organise a collection and make payment, please contact the City on 9257 9999.

Residents will need to place items neatly on their verge. Please note: we are unable to collect from inside private property. Payment can be made over the phone or in person at the City of Kalamunda Administration Building, 2 Railway Road, Kalamunda.

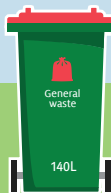


✓ Eligible containers

Bins out for collection

- ✓ Place bins out by 6am on collection day.
- ✓ Keep bins ½ metre clear of obstructions in all directions eg. away from cars, walls, not under or near trees or overhanging objects.
- ✓ Place bins with wheels facing the house.
- ✓ Do not overload your bin (lid needs to be able close) or make it too heavy (no more than 70kg).
- ✓ DO NOT place Household Hazardous Waste (eg. batteries, chemicals) or hot ashes in your bin.
- ✓ Ensure the correct items are placed in the correct bin. For more information on what can be placed in your bins, visit: Bins & Collections | City of Kalamunda

Paintback is a waste paint and packaging collection scheme for architectural and decorative paint. Paintback allows free disposal of paint products of up to 100L or 100kgs for both households and trades. Red Hill Waste Management Facility operate a conveniently located collection point, 1094 Toodyay Road, Red Hill. Note: The Walliston Transfer Station does not accept paint.

The skip bin service is an on-demand service. Residents can select from either a general waste bin (blue) or green waste bin (green). Households are entitled to any combination of three skip bins per financial year (excludes commercial and industrial premises). Both the general and green waste skip bins are 3 cubic metres.

Households that meet the following criteria are entitled to additional green waste bin(s) only, to assist with bush fire management.

- » One additional green waste bin is available for properties 2000m² – 5000m²
- » Two additional green waste bins are available for properties over 5000m²

Please remember

- » Skip bins cannot be placed within private property
- » Bins must remain where they are placed
- » Keep the area clear so the Cleanaway driver can easily remove the bin
- » Bins may be delivered full, but will be emptied by 6pm at the latest the same day
- » If a bin needs to be emptied by the City of Kalamunda due to misuse, the resident will be responsible for all costs incurred
- » Day of use is the day following delivery, book gardeners or help accordingly. For more information on delivery see: www.kalamunda.wa.gov.au/residents/waste-recycling/skip-bins
- » Allocations have to be used by 30 June each year - i.e. Delivered on-site by 30 June

Green Waste collected from the Green Waste skip bins is mulched & re-used, reducing the amount of waste sent to landfill. Please keep green waste free of contamination.

Ordering a Skip Bin

The City has an online booking system allowing residents to register details, book days in advance and view allocations.

We diverted 100 tonnes from landfill through the Second Chance Reuse Shop in its 1st year of operation (2022).

There are **GREAT** sorts in every Kalamunda street who put **60% less** into their landfill bin. In fact we can all become **GREAT** sorts just by remembering:

- G** is for gifting reusable things to charity, swapping or selling
- R** is for recycling only these five things — Paper, Cardboard, Plastic, Glass and Cans
- E** is for earth cycling food scraps and garden waste into compost
- A** is for avoiding excess packaging and disposables
- T** is for taking batteries, e-waste and chemicals to special drop off points

It's about doing better than the bin and treating landfill as the very last resort. Be a **GREAT sort!**

Tenants are advised to contact their real estate agents or property owners to obtain their Entry Pass. Please note your driver's licence must match your address.

The Entry Pass (EP) allows four free entries per year for the following wastes/combination of wastes:

Building rubble	Glass (excl. bottles)	Timber
General	Mattresses	White goods

The EP allows unlimited access for the following waste types:

All metal types (cut to a max. of 1.5m length, width, height & not solid)

Bottletop lids (plastic)	Electronic waste	Green waste

Coffee pods	Glass bottles	Polystyrene

The following items are NOT accepted:

Commercial fees* are applicable in any of the following situations:

- Commercial/trade waste
- Your vehicle or trailer is commercially signed or badged.
- Your waste is from a work site
- You are transporting waste for a fee or reward

For residents wanting to dispose of general waste, green waste or recycling at the Walliston Transfer Station with branded/commercial vehicles and/or trucks up to 3.5T GVM, a permit* is required. Please visit the City's website for a permit application form.

- A vehicle permit is required for oversized trailers (maximum 12ft x 6ft) to dispose of green waste only
- No horse floats or car towing trailers permitted
- No trucks over 3.5T
- No trailers over 12ft
